Please Follow these Instructions for a Separation Divorce Carefully

1. **File out the “Divorce Information Worksheet” *completely*. Please make sure the email address is clear.** (Missing information will delay the process. Do not print these documents back to back. **Print each on a separate page.** Do not use whiteout, correction ribbon or erasers on any of the signatures or dates. The court will not accepted documents that have been corrected.)
2. Sign and date the “Verification” document.
3. **Sign the “Notice To Defendant” document; also known as "Plaintiff's Affidavit under Section 3301(d) of the Divorce Code."** (Please *do not* date this document. I will date it when I file the papers with the court.)
4. Fill out the “Certificate of Non-Military Service.” **Then sign it in front of a notary.** (Make sure this document is returned to me notarized.) **This is a declaration by you (the Plaintiff) that your spouse (the Defendant) is not currently in the military.**
5. Read and sign the “Retainer Agreement.” Once this document is received, it will be signed by the attorney and a copy will be emailed to you along with the complaint after it has been filed with the court.
6. **Include your check or money order for \$495.00.** (This is the total amount for attorney fees and court costs.) If you are going to pay with a credit card, call my office at (717) 854-6400 to make the payment.
7. **Mail all these documents and the payment to our office at:**

8. As soon as I receive your documents and your payment, I will prepare a draft divorce complaint and email you this draft for your review.
9. Once you review the complaint, I will file it with the court. When the court returns the docketed complaint, a copy will be emailed to you with instructions. **PLEASE MAKE SURE YOUR SPOUSE, AND ONLY YOUR SPOUSE SIGNS FOR THE DOCUMENTS.**
10. When I receive from you or your spouse proof that the complaint was served, you will receive an email or a call with the remaining process.
11. Feel free to email me with any questions you may have. I will be more than happy to answer any of your concerns.

RETAINER AGREEMENT
AGREEMENT OF SERVICES TO BE RENDERED

By payment of the fee of \$495.00, _____, [Hereinafter, "Client"] does hereby agree that Abraham B. Cardenas, Esquire [Hereinafter, "Attorney"] shall serve as his/her attorney in a divorce that will be filed on Client's behalf in Cameron County, Pennsylvania.

- I. The following matters are to be undertaken by ATTORNEY for the CLIENT pursuant to this agreement:
1. Intake of relevant information and preparation of divorce complaint;
 2. Filing of a divorce complaint in Cameron County, Pennsylvania;
 3. Service of the complaint on the Defendant by Email or Certified Mail (One Attempt);
 4. Occasional emails or phone calls to client to inform them of case status.
 5. Service of all necessary documents on the Defendant to finalize the divorce;
 6. Obtaining of divorce decree and providing client with one certified copy.
- II. The CLIENT understands and agrees that this fee agreement is for a flat fee only for the services listed above and does not include legal services in connection with the any other services. It is further understood that this fee is for a divorce case where both parties are going to cooperate in the process. **This fee is non-refundable once the divorce case is filed and partly refundable prior to a filing.** CLIENT will be required to pay ATTORNEY additional fees for any additional legal services required. Examples of additional legal services requiring additional fees are:
1. Reinstatement of the divorce complaint with the court because of a delay due to Plaintiff's or Defendant's action (For example, not picking up certified mail or signing acceptance of service form on time.)
 2. Requiring additional service by certified mail or personal service because of change of address or defendant's refusal to pick up his/her certified mail or signing of acceptance of service form .
 3. Any request to terminate or delay the divorce action.
 4. Having to modify or amend a divorce complaint.
 5. Preparation of a Marriage Settlement Agreements, support agreements, custody and visitation agreement for an additional fee of \$450.00. **(If any of these services are required, the attorney must be notified before the divorce is started in order to properly prepare the complaint.)**
 6. Name change process. (This can be done after the divorce is granted for an additional fee of \$85.00.)

Pennsylvania Rule of Professional Conduct 1.4(c) requires that you, as a client, be informed in writing if a lawyer does not have at least \$100,000 per occurrence and \$300,000 in the aggregate per year of professional liability insurance and if, at any time, a lawyer's professional liability insurance drops below either of those amounts or a lawyer's professional liability insurance coverage is terminated. Professional liability insurance is not mandatory or required. You are therefore advised that Abraham B. Cardenas, Esquire does not have professional liability insurance coverage of at least \$100,000 per occurrence and \$300,000 in the aggregate per year.
